The Brief

This kitchen was cramped and dated. We wanted to bring it to the 21st century and put the clients' personality all over it.

I started by changing the layout to open up the small space. This gave us room to add a coffee bar and update the flow of the space. We added a coffee bar and a wooden beam to warm up the space.

With the white cabinets and backsplash, I added an analogous color scheme with blues and greens. Keeping the accents neutral by adding camel colored stools and a white quartz with blue veining tied everything together.

Builder Grade Kitchen Remodel



The Brief

These clients came to me with a builder grade kitchen that was screaming to be remodeled. The original layout didn't include a peninsula, the space was lacking storage, and the floors needed an update. I worked with them to decide on a new layout which included a coffee and wine bar, larger uppers, and more practical and useful lowers. They liked the look of a rustic, Italian kitchen, but wanted to keep with the modern finishes of the rest of the house.

In order to cover this brief, we found a rich, indigo color for the cabinets that will be timeless, and a rustic, white subway style tile with texture and dark grout. We found a one basin, stainless apron sink and brushed nickel finishes to balance the warmth of the new finish on the floors.

Works In Progress: living Room layout





This client was unique in that her husband was going to build custom cabinets for their TV wall, so I helped to make space for it and suggested a size and style for them that went with the era of the house.


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Works In Progress: A New Kytchen




Norks in Progress: E-Design, Net Bar


Redesign an entire ground floor for a mother of two. Must include


- Open plan to incorporate dining, kitchen and living

- An open foyer greets you with a closet for storage.
- Full bath with a spacious, stand up shower and a vanity with storage.

- A combination guest and office space with large windows on either outside wall allows guests to feel at home and gives the client's children a place with lots of natural evening light to do their studying
- By moving the kitchen to the southwest corner of the house and adding backsplash and transom windows, the client will take advantage of the morning light and bring the outside in.
- Delivering on the open floorplan request, the kitchen opens to the living room
- To finish the space, storage was added anywhere it could be, including a pantry and cabinets under the stairs


NOTES

To achieve this color scheme, I will keep the walls light and neutral, while using Black Magic on the woodwork and dark wood floors, accenting the horizontal lines and making the space appear wider. The split complimentary colors of Bosporus and Cape Verde furniture to be the accents. The kitchen will have Cape Verde green cabinets with a white backsplash using dark gray grout. I'll also make the hallway and ceilings in the snowbound color, to keep the space feeling light and contribute to the openness of the space. The bathroom will be a monochrome scheme using the blue Bosporus, giving the illusion of more space; green will do a similar job in the laundry room. The accent colors are both cool, and the chromas are very similar.

Create a tranquil, earthy space with a boho feel. A vanity, color scheme, storage and new furnishings were all needed to complete the space.

After our initial questionnaire and meeting, I created a 3D rendering using SketchUp to show client my proposal and spatial planning. A shoppable sample board was sent as well for the client to complete her space.



The Coastal theme is brought forth in this mood board through the use of light colors, airy furniture and decor pieces, and the blending of indoors with outdoors. The natural materials used in the furniture blurs the line between outside and inside while making the space feel welcoming. The caning of wicker into curved lines is used along many of the pieces providing harmony, while also giving a casual and graceful movement to the space. The curved lines of the furniture, lighting and mirror give a softening and graceful movement to the room, while contributing to the airy feeling. The framed image serves as both inspiration for the room and as artwork that could be used in such a space. Accent pieces such as lamps, throw pillows and vases are shown in blues and taupe adding to the harmony of the space. The light wooden floors reflect sandy beaches, again bringing nature inside. To add to the harmony of the board, patterns are reflected within each individual piece including the pendant light, mirror, each chair, rug, coffee table and the storage piece.

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This split complimentary board encompasses all of the feelings of a contemporary living room. Using black and white as accents againts a bold, dark color palette gives the space a sophistication while the rug adds an element of fun. The soft furnishings are in curving lines, giving the space a feeling of comfort and casualness.





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
